

Uniform and Dress Code Policy

The All Saints School uniform promotes school pride, encourages respectful behavior, and helps create an environment focused on learning. Parents are expected to ensure their child arrives at school in proper uniform each day. The Principal reserves the right to make final decisions regarding the interpretation and enforcement of this policy.

Purchasing Uniforms

Most uniform items require the official school logo. Girls' jumpers, girls' skirts, cardigans, and coats/jackets do not require a logo. **P.E. shirts are purchased through the school office.**

Daily Uniform Requirements

Boys (Kindergarten–Grade 8)

Day	Uniform Requirements
Monday & Friday (P.E.)	Red P.E. shirt; navy uniform shorts/pants or plain navy athletic shorts/pants; all-black athletic shoes with black soles
Tuesday & Thursday	White logo polo; navy chino shorts or navy slacks; all-black athletic shoes with black soles; Grades 2–8 must wear solid black belts with shorts and slacks.
Wednesday & Mass Days	White logo dress shirt (no polo); solid navy tie; navy slacks; Grades 2–8 wear belts; all-black dress shoes; no shorts
Socks	White, navy-blue, or black socks covering the ankle bone.

Girls (Kindergarten–Grade 8)

Day	Uniform Requirements
Monday & Friday (P.E.)	Red P.E. shirt; navy uniform shorts/pants or plain navy athletic shorts/pants; all-black athletic shoes with black soles
Tuesday & Thursday	White logo polo; navy shorts or slacks; navy or plaid jumper; all-black athletic shoes; Grades 2–8 must wear black belts with shorts/slacks
Wednesday & Mass Days	White logo dress blouse (no polo); solid navy cross tie; navy skirt, navy jumper, or plaid jumper; all-black flat dress shoes; no shorts or slacks
Socks/Hosiery	White, navy-blue, or black socks, tights, or knee socks.

Not Permitted: Leggings; polo dresses.

Accessories and Personal Appearance

- Grades 2–8 must wear a solid black belt with shorts or slacks that have belt loops.
- Makeup and nail polish are not permitted.
- Girls may wear one pair of small post earrings in the earlobes.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- Jewelry is limited to:
 - One ring per hand
 - One watch
 - One necklace with a single religious pendant
- Smartwatches or watches capable of communication are not permitted.
- Distracting accessories may be removed and held by school personnel.
- Hair bows and accessories must be navy blue.

Grooming Standards

Students should arrive at school clean, neat, and well groomed.

- Hair must be clean, neatly styled, and a natural color.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted.
- Boys' hair should be kept above the ears, collar, and eyebrows whenever possible.
- Middle school boys must be clean-shaven.

Dress Down Days (Students must dress modestly and appropriately)

Dress down days are scheduled for special occasions. Students not complying with the guidelines set forth for dress down days may include a loss of future dress down day privileges.

Acceptable Attire

- Modest shirts and tops
- T-shirts with appropriate messages
- Shorts similar in length to uniform shorts
- Skirts no shorter than two inches above the knee
- Closed-toe shoes

Not Permitted

- Tank tops or spaghetti straps
 - Tight, revealing, or low-cut clothing
 - Leggings worn as pants (may only be worn under skirts or dresses)
 - Jeans with holes or tears
 - Flip-flops
 - High heels
 - Pajamas or sleepwear
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Outerwear

Approved Indoor Outerwear

- Navy-blue cardigan
- Plain navy-blue pullover sweater
- Plain navy-blue jacket
- Red P.E. sweatshirt on P.E. days

Approved Outdoor Outerwear

- Blue or black coats and jackets

Not Permitted

- Denim jackets or outerwear
- Outerwear with large logos or brand names
- Hooded jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts and similar casual outerwear

Hats, sunglasses, coats, and windbreakers **may not** be worn inside the school building.

Additional Expectations

- Uniform shirts must remain tucked in throughout the school day.
- Students are expected to follow the uniform policy at all school-sponsored activities unless otherwise specified.
- Repeated uniform violations may result in loss of Dress Down Day privileges and other disciplinary consequences.
